# *Why is Restoration such a Delicate Matter?*

## **The Answer is Fourfold!**

1. Because the process involves human beings who are fragile and complicated and sometimes hurt. Yet they bear the image of God. Thus, they deserve to be treated with dignity and respect even when caught in a sin against us.
2. Because none of us is a perfect example of God's righteousness. We all experience the tug-of-war that takes place between the flesh and the Spirit. Since we all have a sinful nature, sooner or later we all will need a helping hand up.
3. Because the purpose of the Gospel is to mend and not cripple. It's painful enough to be trapped by sin. We don't need another person entering our lives and inflicting more pain.
4. Because we are commanded to be a living testimony of God's love. To do this effectively we cannot run from the scene or stand on the side lines feeling smug. Remember one day you too may be in a similar situation and you will want others to apply the Golden Rule to you.
