Let's Review Chapters 5 & 6!

I. (5:1-12) Paul **Exhorts** us to live in Liberty!

II. (5:13-15) Paul **Explains** that liberty is revealed by LOVE!

III. (5:16-26) Paul calls us to **Evaluate** our LIVES!

IV. (6:1-10) Paul gives two **Examples** of how LIBERTY and LOVE are to be applied in our LIVES!

A. (6:1-5) **1ST Example**: The Spirit filled man's deeds before those who are **not** Spirit filled!

B. (6:6-10) **2ND Example**: The Spirit filled man's deeds before those who **are** Spirit filled!

Today's Sermon!

Question: How is Christ's divine love to be applied in our lives?
(Galatians 5:13-14 / John 13:34f)

Answer: Focuses not only on those we need to be watching (6:1-5),
but also those who God sends to watch over us (6:6-10).

- I. (6:1-5) How the Spirit filled person is to respond
to those who are NOT walking in the Spirit
- II. (6:6-10) How the Spirit filled person is to respond
to those who ARE walking in the Spirit!

- A. (v.6) Christ's divine law (love/5:14) is to be practiced!
- B. (vs.7-8) Christ's divine law is explained!
- C. (v.9) Christ's divine law will bring reward!
- D. (v.10) Christ's divine law is to be applied!

Four Points of Application!

- 1. Let's share our finances!** Paul wants us to relax our grip on our funds and invest them in the lives of those who feed our souls. Those who help us the most in our daily walk with God, should receive the largest share of our giving.
- 1. Let's sow in the Spirit and not in the flesh!** Holiness begets holiness and wickedness begets wickedness. We cannot sow our wild oats during the week, and then, expects God to answer our prayer for a large harvest on Sunday!
- 1. Let's not grow tired of doing good!** If we grow tired and sow sparingly, we cannot expect an abundance in the harvest. Remember God will reward us, so continue to fight the good fight!
- 1. Let's do good to all men, but especially to believers!** We are to be living testimonies to God's Gospel message. Since God has forgiven us, we are called to forgive others – no matter if they're saved or lost!
