#### Three Lessons from Today's Sermon!

1. In chapter 14 (and chapter 15 also) various details of the world scene taking place in heaven and on earth are given in anticipation of the final bowl judgments revealed in chapter 16. These details are also given so that we might have insight into the judgments upon political and religious Babylon described in chapters 17 and 18. In other words these insights are preparatory.

#### Three Lessons from Today's Sermon!

2. Taken as a whole, chapter 14, on the one hand is a reminder of God's preserving of the 144,000 Jews during the time of the Great Tribulation; and on the other hand it graphically declares some of the terrible judgments that will be inflicted on the world as a result of its rejection of the Gospel message.

#### Three Lessons from Today's Sermon!

3. Chapter 14 can also be viewed as a brief outline of the coming major

events that will soon take place on earth during the end times.

For example in chapter 14 we see:

- a. The appearing of a godly Jewish remnant (Roman 9-11).
- b. The final call to the Gentile to be blessed (Genesis 12).
